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- (B) Short answer questions: Answer <u>Two</u> of the four questions. Please provide answers in the script book provided. The total mark for this section is 20 marks, each question is worth 10 marks:
- (1) What is gross motor behavior? Outline the development of gross motor behavior in infancy period.
- (2) Outline Kubler-Ross's stages of dying.
- (3) Define the following terms: (i) egocentrism, (ii) animism, (iii) object permanence.
- (4) State and define any 3 of the cognitive abilities that people will develop according to Piaget's concrete operational stage.
- (C) Long answer questions: Answer Two of the four questions. Please provide answers in the script book provided. The total mark for this section is 40 marks, each question is worth 20 marks:
- (1) What are secure, avoidant and anxious attachment style? Discuss how each of them will affect adult's romantic relationship.
- (2) In the adolescence period, discuss how sexual maturation affects adolescents' behaviors.
- (3) Differentiate the differences between cross-sectional design and longitudinal design and discuss their relative strengths and limitations in studying human development.
- (4) Outline and explain Kohlberg's Theory of Moral Development. Appropriate example(s) should be used to illustrate the development in each stage. School

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
