6. Briefly define channeling hypothesis [1.5pt]. Provide 1 example for how this hypothesis works [1.5pt].
7. Mood is a subjective experience similar to, but not identical with, emotion. How are they similar and how are they different? List 3 similarities OR differences [1pt for each].
8. What is subjective well-being (happiness) [1pt]? Can the pursuit of subjective well-being be inappropriate or have a downside? List 2 possible downsides [1pt for each].
