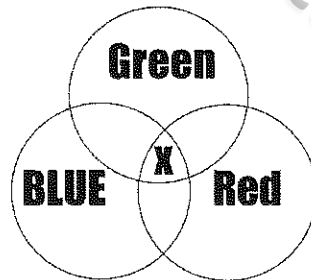

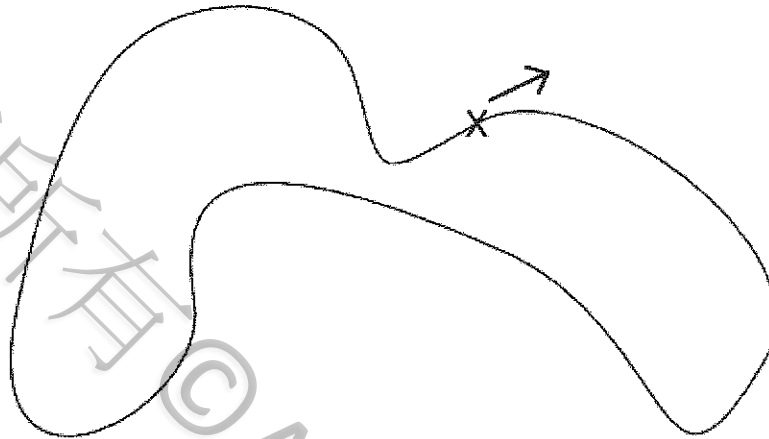


6. The color wheel used in the above question (Q.5) is for mixing pigments or color lights?
